In *Every student, every classroom every day*, I articulated our aspiration for every student to unlock and fulfil their learning potential. As part of this, we know that students who finish Year 12 have better post-school outcomes, and that this is magnified when students achieve a WACE. We also know that students who engage with more challenging content, concepts and courses are better prepared for a broader range of post-school options.

Through our analysis of 2021 senior secondary student performance data, it is clear that Central Midlands Senior High School has had a significant positive impact on Year 12 outcomes in 2021, and that you have maintained a strong focus on students fulfilling their learning potential.

In determining the schools that have performed particularly well in 2021, a school's overall performance was considered, taking into account the students who commenced in Year 11 and completed Year 12 with a WACE, as well as the progress and achievement of your Year 12 cohort, based on their Year 9 NAPLAN results.
